## Viva Quad Cities 1st Annual Scholarship Award Dinner and Fiesta

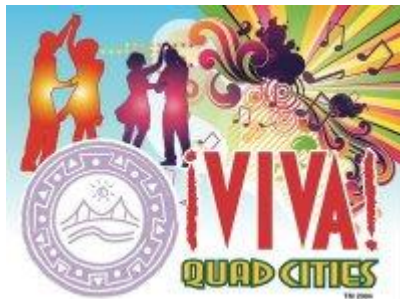
