Within the first three years, we developed the Mariachi curriculum that was strategically aligned with the state standards for Band, Choir and Orchestra and was the first of its kind. Mariachi is now recognized in the school district with 18 schools offering Mariachi as part of their Fine Arts curriculum along with close to 3,500 students currently enrolled in Mariachi classes. We noticed an immediate impact in student participation, but we also noticed an even bigger impact with the parents of those students who greatly supported our efforts and their students. From the beginning with Mariachi Los Changuitos Feos from Tucson, Arizona in 1964, the first student Mariachi in the US, to the explosion of regional conferences beginning in Texas, Arizona, and California, to the newly developed school based Mariachi programs sprouting all over the US. Mariachi education is growing rapidly and I'm very proud to be a part of the West Music team as we

continue to not only provide, but also develop the very best in Mariachi instruments, educational resources and accessories for both educators and professionals alike"
