In 2009, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) created a pilot internship program with Spelman College to encourage young women to pursue transportation as a career. The program was a part of a broader effort, led by the White House Council on Women and Girls, to ensure that federal programs and policies take into account the distinct needs and concerns of women and girls. Due to the success of the pilot program, the Women and Girls Internship Program was expanded to the regional SBTRCs, including the Great Lakes Region. The internships are a direct way to help educate the participating women on the exciting opportunities available in the transportation infrastructure industry and inspire them to enter the science, engineering, and technology fields.

Interns through the program are placed at transportation related companies and government agencies when they are attending school during fall or spring semesters. The student applicants can be of any level at an accredited university (undergraduate, graduate, etc), and come from many different disciplines. We ask that companies interested in participating indicate the preference on class level and majors for us to better match students.
